## **Working Environment §16 Vessels**

### **PURPOSE**

To teach the participants how to work in the safety organisation on board in order to improve the safety as well as the working environment.

### **CONTENT**

In groups each participant will work with the Danish Safety and Working Environment legislation and procedures. They will learn how to work in the safety organisation on board in a structured way using, analysing, problem solving, meeting and communication skills. There will be an introduction to chemicals and other exposures affecting the health on a short and long-term basis.

As in the Safety Organisation onboard they will work with near misses and accident investigation and learn how to make risk assessment and Work Place Instructions.

### **OBJECTIVES**

After the course the participants can be an active part of the Safety Organisation onboard and know about meeting and teamwork skills. The participants are able to find relevant information in legislation, procedures and other publications.

### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

All crewmembers, but mandatory for members of the Safety Group on board Danish flagged vessels.

**DURATION:** 3 days. Combined with Danish Maritime Legislation. If this course is combined with §16, the program will continue with 2 days more which will be the last 2 days from the §16 Course. Four days total.

**PARTICIPANTS:** Maximum 15. **LANGUAGE:** English
